APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN FOR 2024 SAINT THERESE YOUTH VOLUNTEER SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Saint Louis Park, Minn. (December 12, 2023) – Senior living organization Saint Therese, has opened the application process for its annual Youth Volunteer Scholarships. Each year, the nonprofit awards two \$2,000 scholarships to youth volunteers who have spent time impacting the lives of seniors in a care facility, independent or assisted living, senior day program or in a neighborhood or community.

This year, for the first time, the scholarships are also open to youth volunteers in two Michigan counties, as Saint Therese assumed ownership of IHM Senior Living Community in Monroe, Mich.

To be eligible, youth volunteers must currently be in grades 11-12 during the 2023-24 school year and have completed a minimum of 20 volunteer hours with one or more seniors by the date of the submission. Volunteer hours may be spent in such ways as: companionship visits, helping with household chores, raking leaves, shoveling snow, grocery shopping, transportation to appointments, etc.

The application deadline is March 1, 2024. Eligible applicants must reside in the seven county Twin cities metro area (Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, Washington), the Western Wisconsin counties of Pierce and St. Croix, or the Michigan counties of Monroe and Wayne.
